Voters who do not have a photo identity card can vote by showing any one of the following 13 documents AUTHORISED by the Election Commission:

These include passport, driving licence, income tax identity (PAN) card, service identity card issued to employees by the state/central government, public sector undertakings, local bodies or public limited companies with photographs.

Other documents such voters can produce include passbooks issued by public sector banks or post offices and kisan passbooks with photograph (accounts opened up to February 28, 2009), property documents such as pattas, registered deeds with photograph, SC/ST/OBC certificates with photograph (issued up to February 28, 2009), pension documents such as ex-servicemen's pension book/pension payment order, ex-servicemen's widow/dependent certificates, old age pension order, arms licences (issued up to February 28), certificate of physical handicap with photograph, and job cards issued under NREGA.

EC said that any of these documents that is available only to the head of the family may be used for identifying the other members of the family provided all members come together and are identified by the head of the family.
